# **INFANT ADOPTION**



We can help you build your family through infant adoption. In addition to assisting with your required education and home study, we can offer profile and outreach services. Through collaboration with our Minnesota office, your adoption profile will be made visible to expectant parents throughout the U.S. via our website and to pregnancy service clients exploring adoption in Minnesota.

#### **Adoptive Families**

We welcome all families regardless of race, religion, marital status or sexual orientation. Adoptive parents must be at least 25 years of age with no more than 50 years between the younger parent and the child. Exceptions made case-by-case.

#### **Profile Services**

Adoptive families may choose to join our Profile Service as part of their outreach efforts, as space is available. Families may also place their profile on the CH/LSS website. To view waiting families, please visit: chlss.org/waitingfamilies.

# **Open Adoption**

Open adoptions are created by birth families and adoptive families with the best interest of the child at heart. Through open adoption, birth and adoptive families work together to plan a relationship that goes beyond the placement of their child; this relationship is ongoing and involves varying degrees of direct contact with each other. Through openness, children grow up without secrets and with information about their birth family.

When birth parents select you, whether through agency profiles or personal outreach, the next step is a match meeting which provides an opportunity to get together in person prior to committing to a match. If the match is agreed upon, we assist birth parents and adoptive parents in creating an adoption plan and helping plan for the child's birth.

You can receive ongoing support and assistance in building a relationship with the child's birth family, both during the pregnancy and beyond. Because adoption is a lifelong journey, families also have the opportunity to participate in ongoing education, support and referral services through our post adoption services.

Other third-party fees and costs that apply may not be listed.

CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS: Credit cards may be used for all adoption fees, but a processing fee of 2.75% will be charged for VISA, MasterCard and Discover and a 3.5% fee will be charged for American Express. Money order or personal checks are always welcome.
