TOTAL COST: The approximate cost to adopt from Honduras is \$29,315 (not including airfare, lodging and other fees associated with travel, which can vary greatly depending on current airfare rates, family size, length of stay, lodging preferences, and/or seasonality and availability).

This is a good faith estimate of the charges deemed reliable as of **November 1, 2020**. The payment of fees for services rendered does not guarantee the placement of a child. All fees, timelines and program requirements are subject to change. CH Agency fees will be honored at the rate that is current when the signed Fee Agreement is received by Children's Home Society of Minnesota (CH). Country program fees will be billed at the rate in effect at the time the fee is due. All fee increases in excess of \$1,000 will be made in writing. Program Coordination Fee includes one country program change within 4 years of signed Fee Agreement. All other program changes subject to additional fees. CH may reduce, waive or refund fees when 1) deemed by CH to be in the best interest of the child; 2) requested by clients due to hardship; 3) when paid for services which were not completed.

REFUNDS: All fees are non-refundable unless otherwise noted. When client service fees are paid, but the service is not provided, Children's Home may refund the unused portion to prospective adoptive parents. All refunds will be processed within sixty (60) days after the request has been approved and the signed agreement has been returned to the agency.
