Hosting Program Details

Children's Home partners with Kidsave to help older children from Colombia experience the joys of summer and to help them find permanent, loving adoptive families through their Summer Miracles Program. Children stay with host families for 4-5 weeks during the summer in designated communities throughout the United States. Generally, the children range in age from 10 to 14. Some may have siblings. While the children stay here, they learn about the U.S. culture, experience life in an American family, and build lasting relationships with caring adults. Host families work together with the local Kidsave community to help the children meet potential adoptive families. Some families move forward to adopt the children they host.

Once you have completed your host family application process through Kidsave, Children's Home can help you with the required hosting assessment and agency training. Should your family wish to move forward to adopt the child(ren) you hosted, we can also assist you through the adoption process.

Adoption Program Details

If you host a child and choose to proceed with an adoption, you will need to meet eligibility requirements for Colombian adoption. Find additional requirements at chlss.org/colombia.

- Parents must be age 25-55 at time of child referral. They must be at least 15 years and no more than 45 years older than the child they will adopt.
- Gay and lesbian individuals and couples are welcome to apply.
- Parents cannot have serious physical or mental health concerns.
- If married, parents must be married at least two years (pre-marital cohabitation is recognized).
- Singles are eligible to adopt older children or children with identified needs; single men matched with boys only.
- Travel occurs 5-9 weeks after official referral acceptance.
- One trip to Colombia for an average of 3-5 weeks is required. One parent may return to the U.S. after approximately two weeks.
