

Adopt from **COLOMBIA**

Children's Home has been advocating for children in Colombia for more than 40 years. Children of all ages need families, especially children over the age of 7, those in sibling groups, and those living with identified needs ranging from minor/correctable to lifelong. They may have been abandoned, relinquished, or their parents' rights were terminated due to abuse or neglect. Children are cared for in government-run orphanages, foster homes and private adoption homes that are supervised by the country's central adoption authority, the Colombian Institute of Family Welfare (ICBF). ICBF determines the children's eligibility for adoption. Children are generally between the ages of 6 months to 15 years at the time of referral. Children's Home is Hague accredited.

Eligible Families

- Parents must be age 25-55 at time of child referral. They must be at least 15 years and no more than 45 years older than the child(ren) they will adopt.
- Gay and lesbian individuals and couples are welcome to apply.
- If married, parents must be married at least two years (cohabitation recognized).
- Singles may adopt older children or children with identified needs; single men matched with boys only.
- Parents cannot have serious physical or mental health concerns.
- If you are of Colombian heritage, please call us to discuss eligibility guidelines.
- Depending on openness, wait for referral is typically 6-18 months.
- Travel occurs 5-9 weeks after referral acceptance.
- One trip to Colombia for 3-5 weeks is required. One parent may return to the U.S. after approximately 2 weeks.

Country Program Expenses in U.S. - Includes personnel costs, administrative overhead, operational costs, training and education, communication and publications costs, and other costs related to providing adoption services in the U.S. (\$4,000)

Foreign Program Expenses - Includes personnel costs, administrative overhead, training, education, legal services, communications, and any other costs related to providing adoption services in the child's country. The services provided by ICBF are free of charge. (\$4,000)

Care of the Child - Includes costs for food, clothing, shelter and medical care; foster care services, orphanage care; and any other services provided directly to the child(ren). (\$3,000)

Translation and Documents - Includes the costs for obtaining, translating, or copying records or documents required to complete the adoption, costs for the child's Convention court documents, adoption certificate and other documents related to the adoption. (\$3,000)

CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS: Credit cards may be used for all adoption fees, but a processing fee of 2.75-3.5% will be charged based on the credit card used.
